## Support for Local Disaster Relief

Each year, your local Red Cross helps approximately 1,000 people after local disasters such as home fires, hurricanes, floods, tornadoes and other natural and man-made disasters. We give victims a place to stay, food to eat, clothes to wear, crisis counseling, a shoulder to cry on and much more.

Red Cross disaster relief focuses on meeting people's immediate emergency disaster-caused needs. When disaster strikes, the Red Cross addresses basic human needs, giving aid to individuals and families to help them to resume their normal lives.

The Red Cross also feeds emergency workers, handles inquires from concerned family members outside the disaster area, provides blood and blood products to disaster victims, and helps those affected by disaster to access other available resources.
